**CALL TO ORDER**

**FLAG SALUTE** President Wade called the public meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. and began the meeting with a salute to the flag.

**PRESENTATIONS**

- Mary Gilpatrick, Brianna Rolston and students; Carissa Seror and Savannah Coppage presented to the board on a project that the Student Senate is working on titled "Midnight Mirrors". This project will provide prom dresses to those that cannot afford them. They hope to expand it to include gift certificates for tuxedo rentals also.

**SUPERINTENDENT**

- To celebrate volunteerism, the Superintendent recognized the following groups:
  - The board members for their service to the district.
  - The football team for their Autism Awareness fundraising which totaled almost \$4,000.
  - The Booster Club for their continued generosity to the students.
- Rich Pogue provided the board with an update on the Secondary School. Ms. Bergin read an update from Karen Lederman who was unable to attend the meeting.
- Jonathan Smith from CSArch gave the board an update on the solar panel project. Initial year savings in electrical costs are estimated to be \$12,434 for the elementary and secondary schools and bus garage. Twenty year savings are estimated to be \$245,318.
- The board discussed the request by New York Light Energy to use district photos and name on their work vehicles. The board agreed to their request.
